1. Introduction










3. Submitted-Funded-Reserve Participants (for 2018 participants)




4. Gender of coordinators among (189) eligible proposals






5. Gender of coordinators among (73) funded proposals




6. Gender of applicants among (2018) participants






7. Gender of applicants among (777) funded participants




8. SME participation among (189) eligible proposals






9. SME participation among all (73) funded proposals




10. SME participation among all (2018) participants






11. SME participation among all funded (777) participants




12. Cut-off scores (main list)






13. Cut-off scores (reserve list)




14. Number of experts (126) in total






15. Applicants' activity type (for all 2018 participants)
