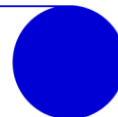

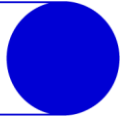

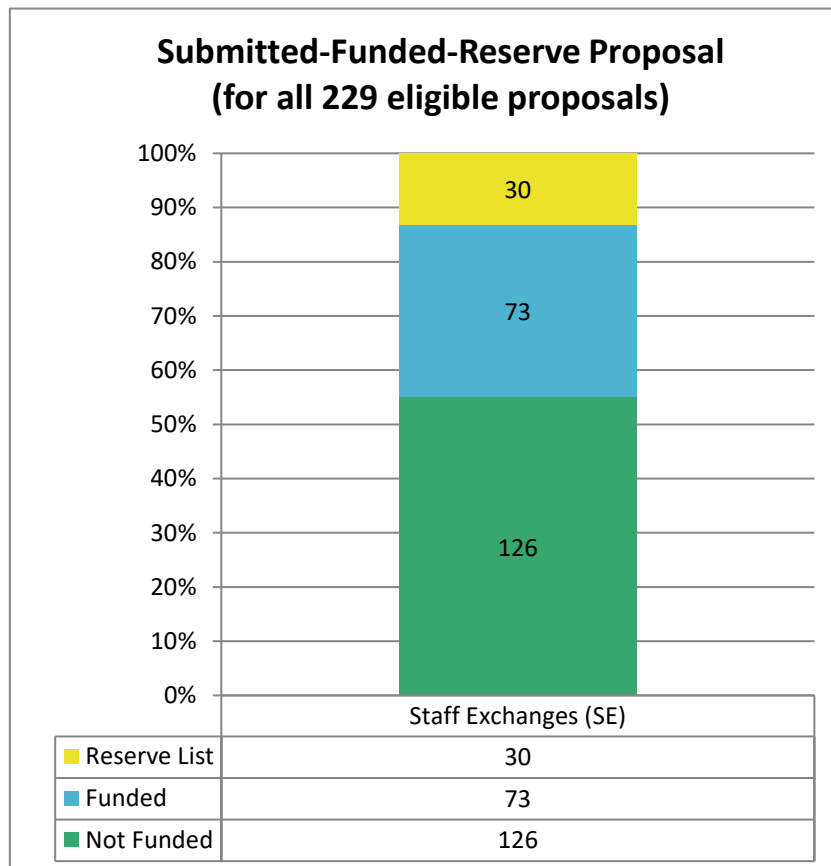
## 1. Introduction

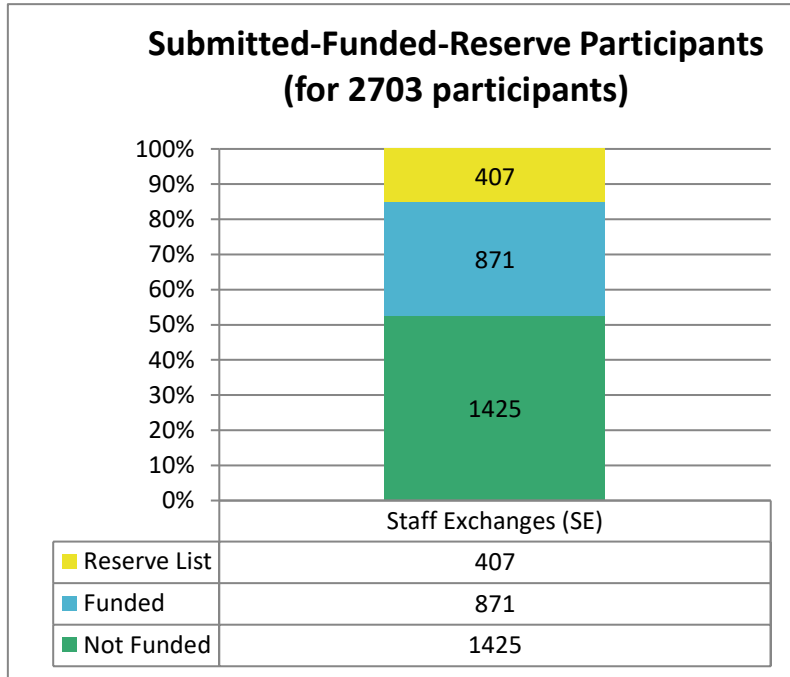

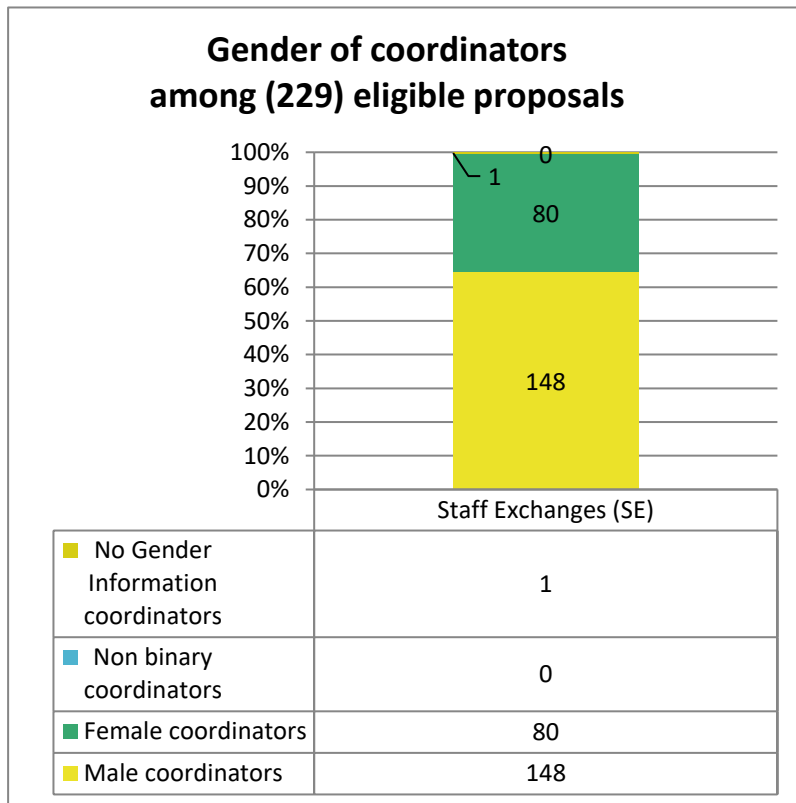

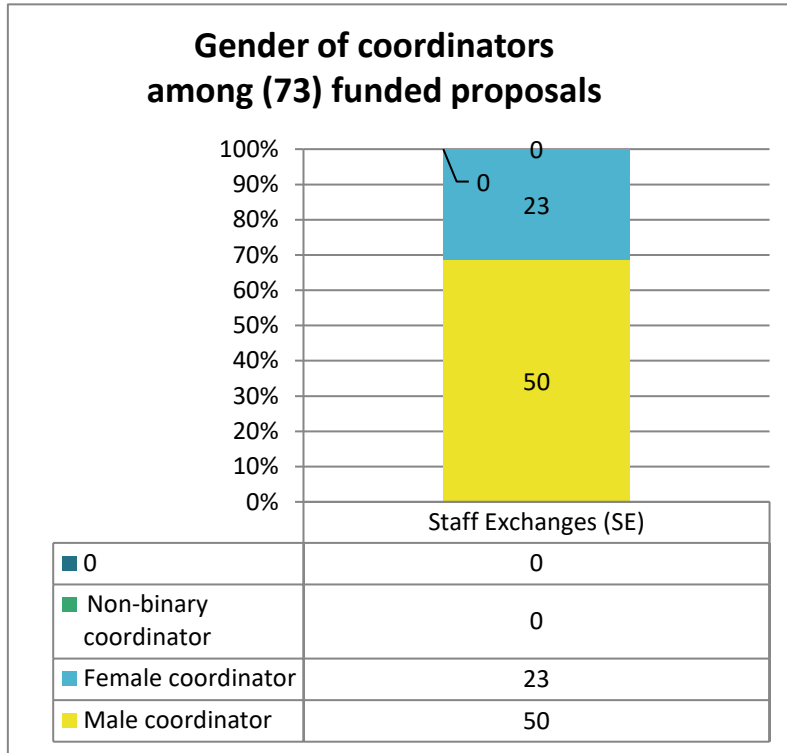

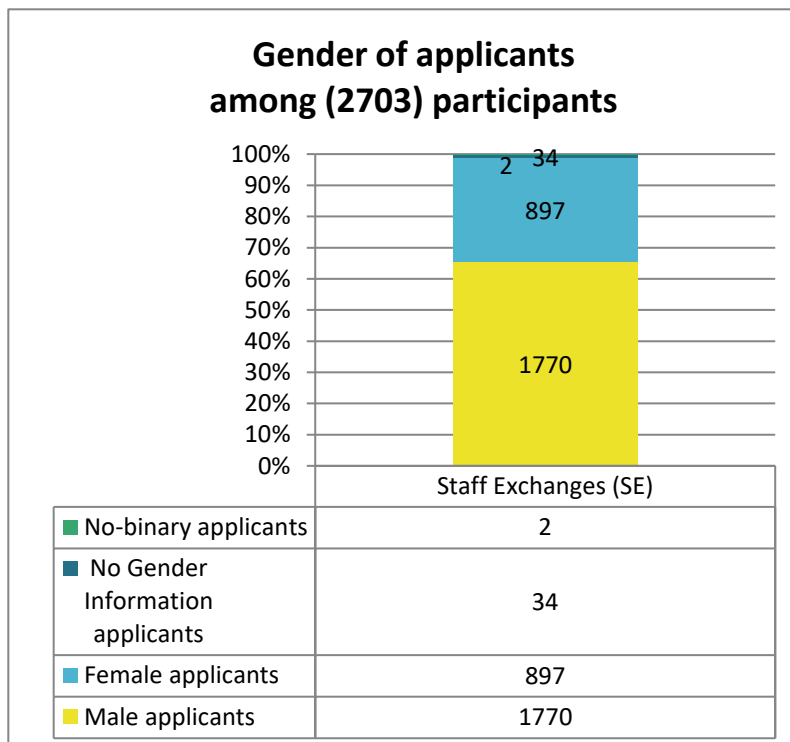
**4. Gender of coordinators among (229) eligible proposals**



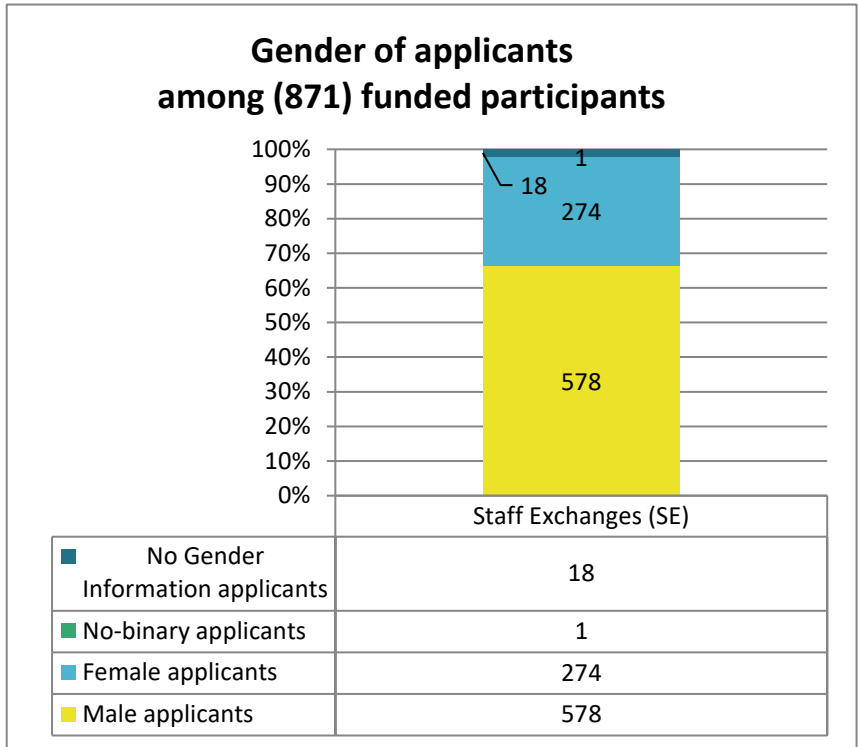
**5. Gender of coordinators among (73) funded proposals**



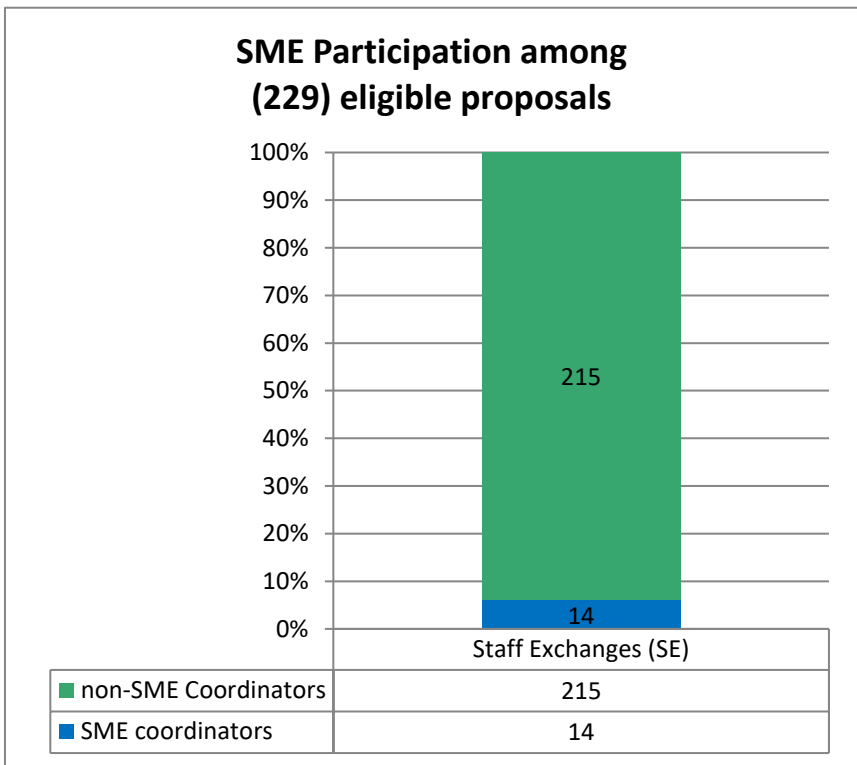

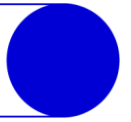


**7. Gender of applicants among (871) funded participants**

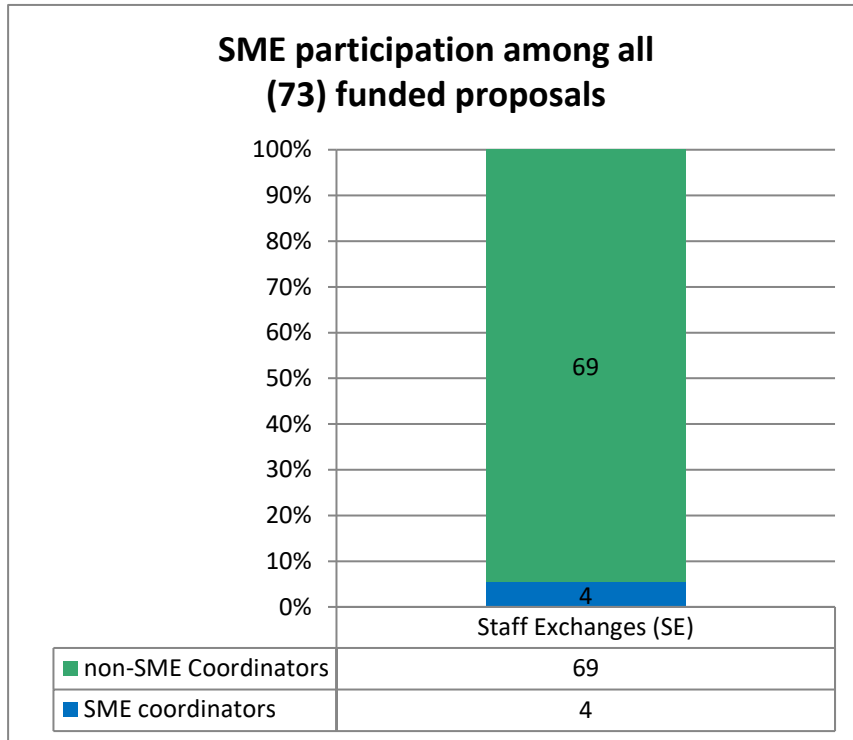


**8. SME participation among (229) eligible proposals**

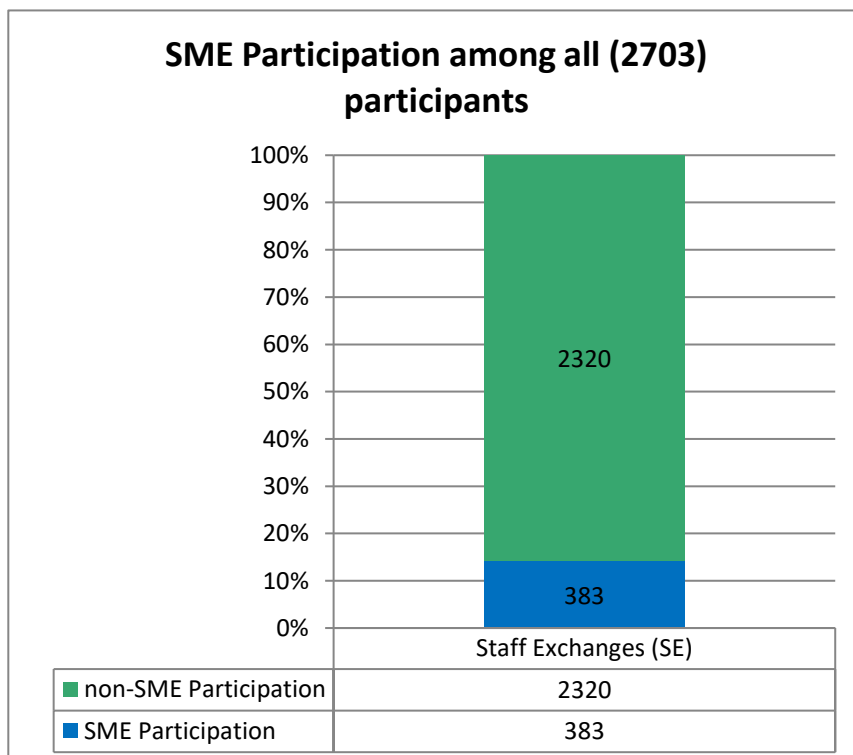




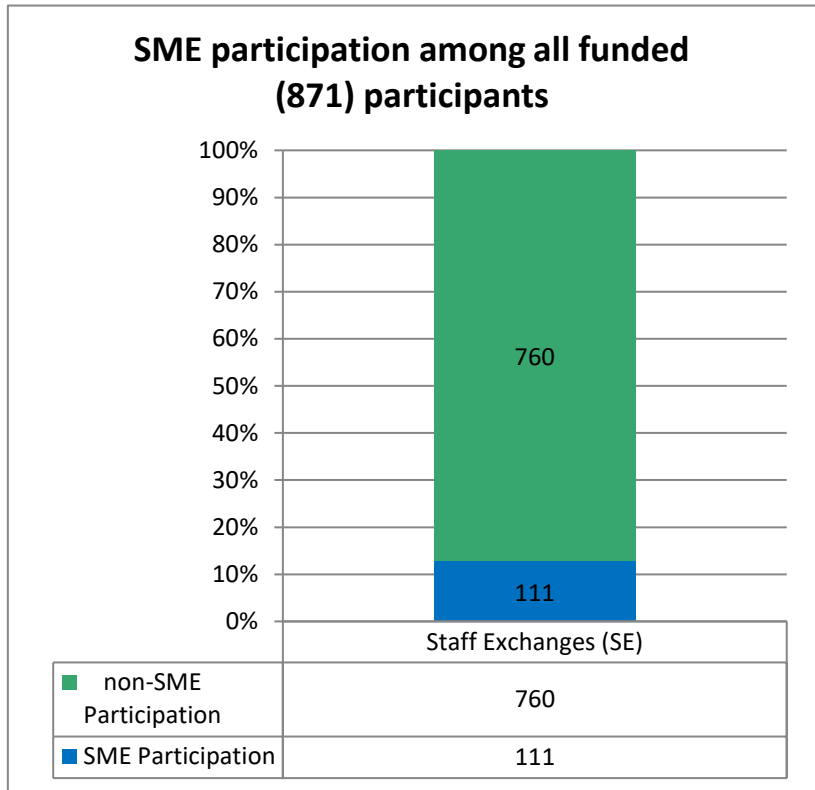
**9. SME participation among all (73) funded proposals**



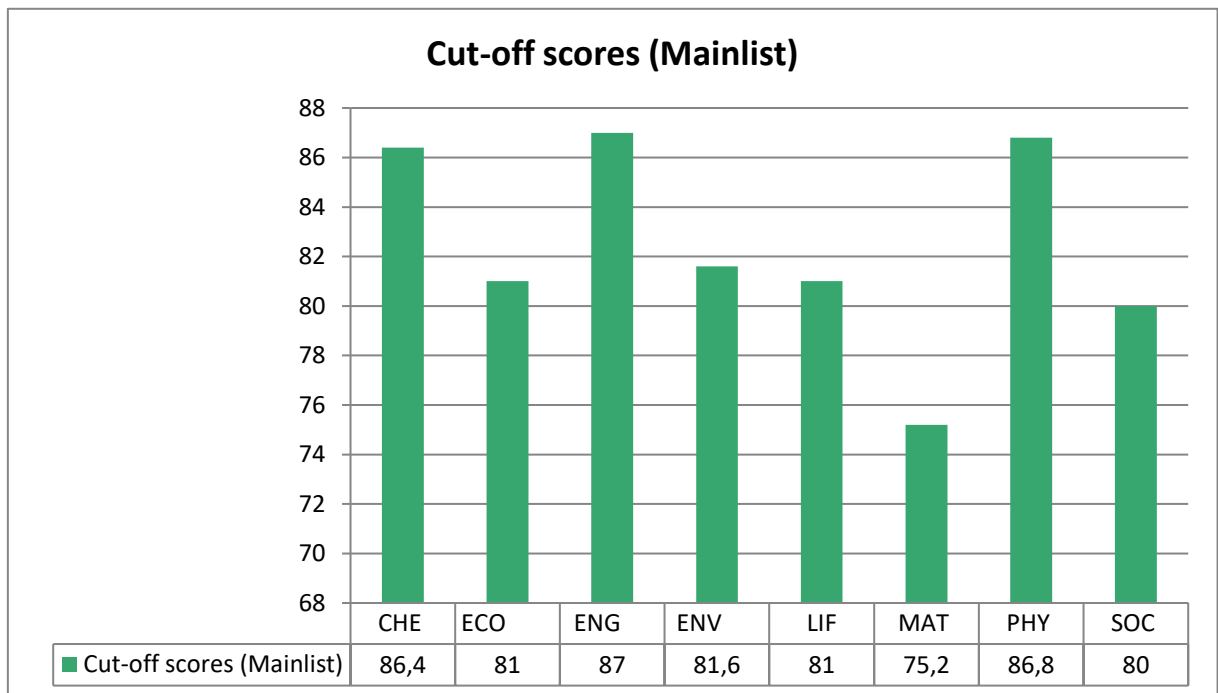
**10. SME participation among all (2703) participants**

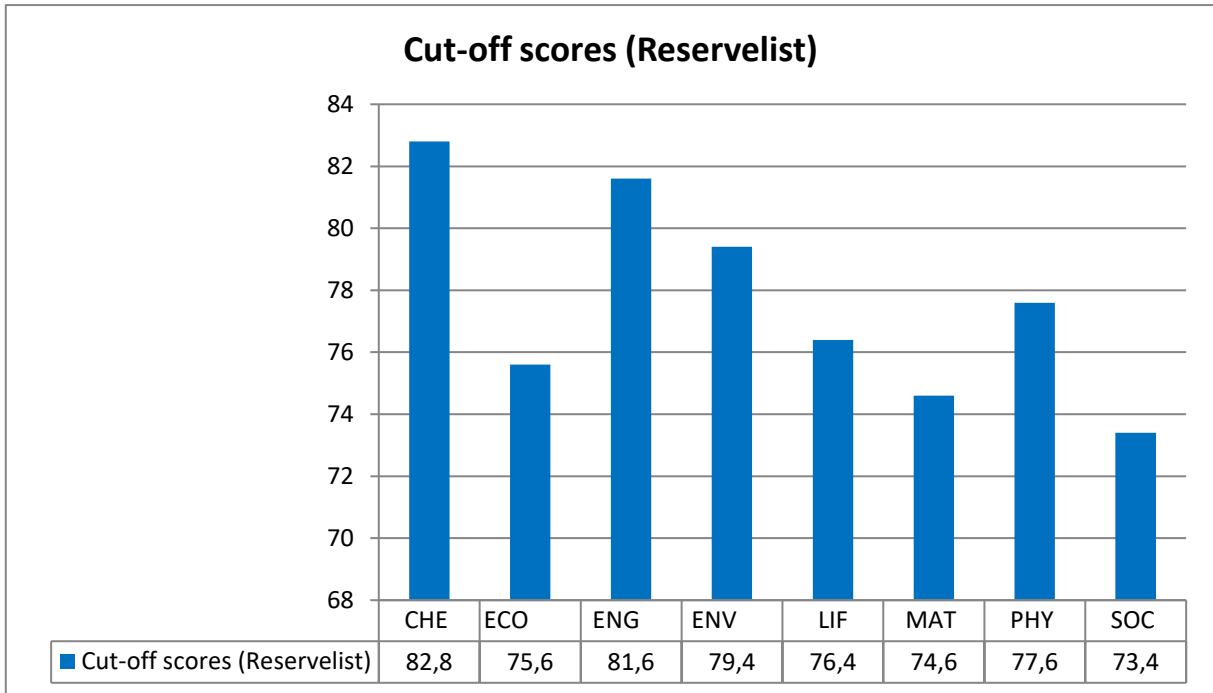

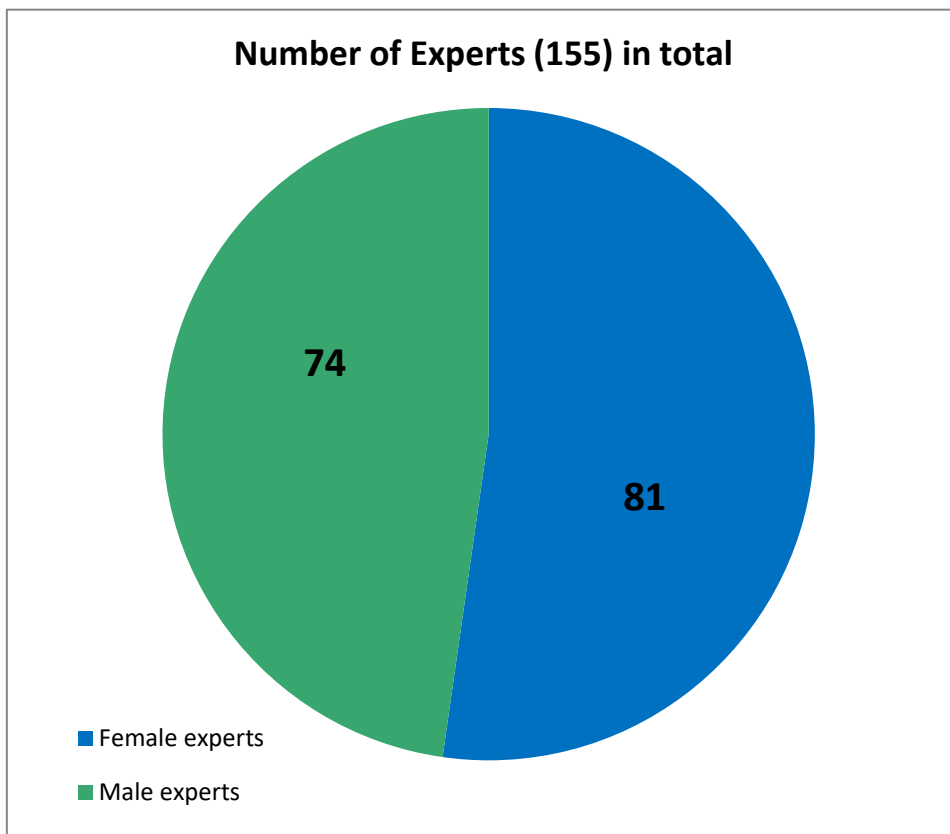

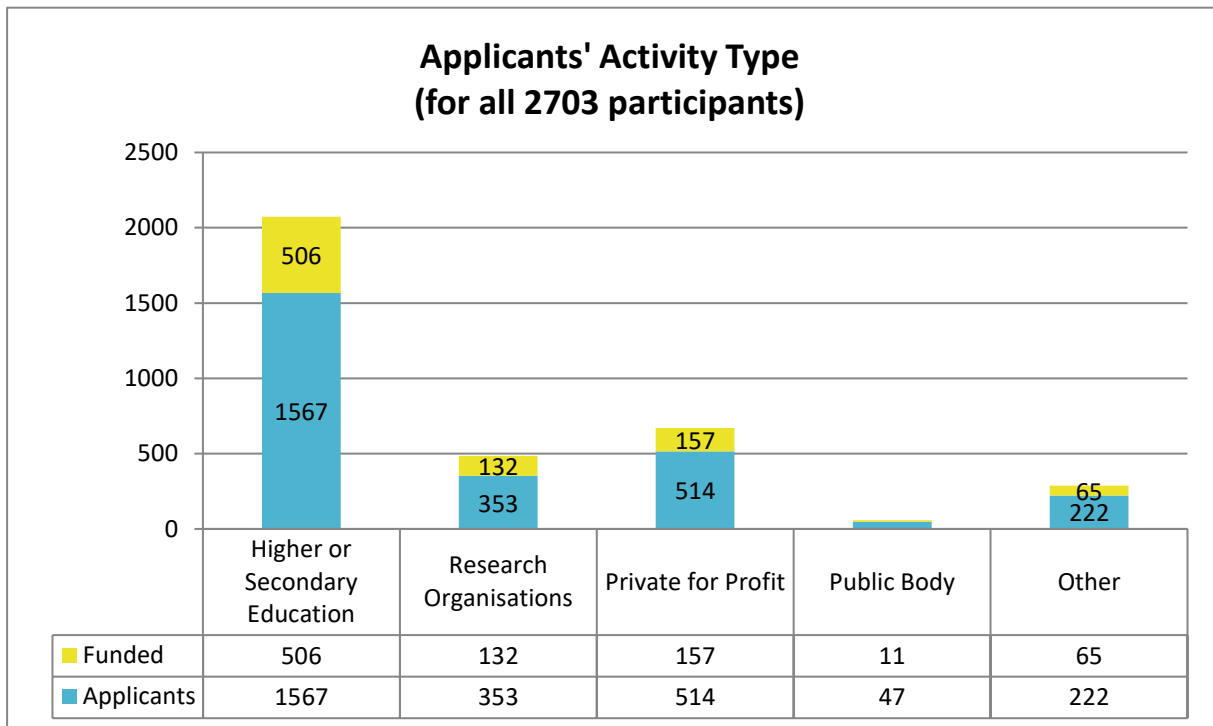

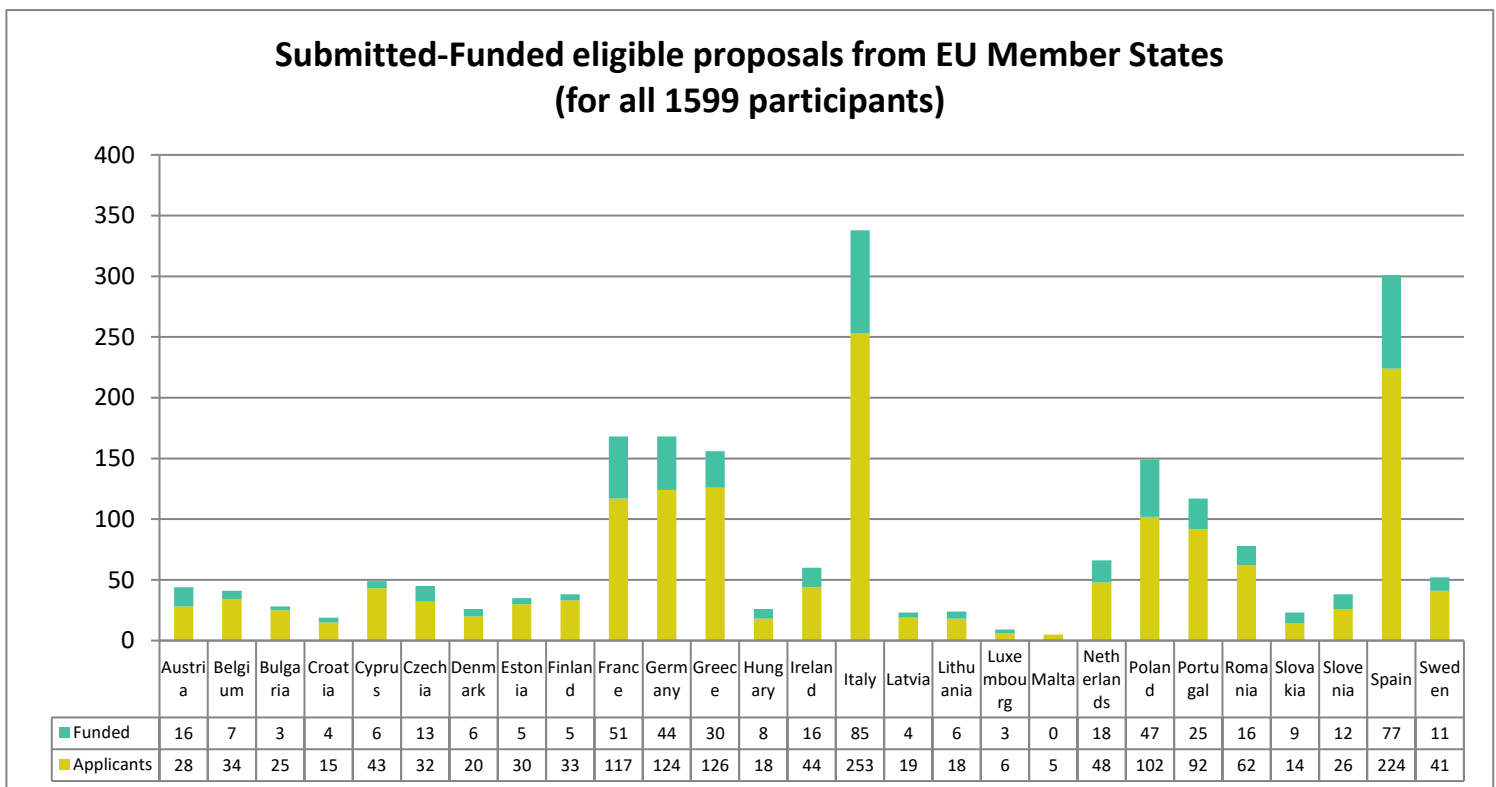


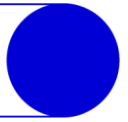


**15. Applicants' activity type (for all 2703 participants)**
